

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how PEGP Limited, a British Virgin Islands entity (“Coinlancer”) collect, stores, uses and protects personal information. You accept this Privacy Policy when you use Coinlancer’s services or any other features, technologies or functionalities offered by Coinlancer on Coinlancer’s web-site or through any other means.

1. Collection of Information

When you use Coinlancer’s web-sites <http://coinlancer.com> or <http://coinlancer.io> (collectively, “Site”) or Coinlancer’s services, you may provide your personal information voluntarily, including but not limited to your name, residential address, email address, and digital wallet address or bank account information, depending on your method of payment. In addition, you may provide some information involuntarily such as any information sent to Coinlancer by your computer, mobile phone or other access device. This information may include your IP address, device information, including but not limited to identifier, name and type, operating system, location, mobile network information and standard web log information, such as your browser type, traffic to and from Coinlancer’s Site and the pages you accessed on Coinlancer’s Site.

In addition, Coinlancer may collect personal information from or about you in other ways such as your interaction with customer support or contractual relationships with Coinlancer.

Coinlancer is not obligated to collect any of your information and may do it at its own discretion.

2. Setting up and Using an Account.

In order to purchase tokens thorough Coinlancer Site, you are required to set up a personal account and provide your personal information such as name and email address to secure your access to your account.

Coinlancer may require you to provide additional information to verify your identity, address or any other information in your account, such as your date of birth, copy of ID, citizenship, country of residence, and other information directly or through a third party. Coinlancer is not obligated to verify your identity or any other personal information and may do it at its own discretion.

You can review your personal information inside of your account. You can edit your personal information or delete your account by contacting Coinlancer customer service. If you cancel or delete your account, Coinlancer may keep your information in its database. This may be necessary to deter fraud by ensuring that a person who tries to commit fraud will not be able to avoid detection simply by closing his/her account and opening a new account. However, if you close your account, your personally identifiable information will not be used by Coinlancer for any further purposes, nor sold or shared with the third parties, except as necessary to prevent fraud or money laundering and assist law enforcement in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

3. Use of Cookies

Coinlancer or its partners may place small data files (cookies) or pixel tags on your computer or other device when you access Coinlancer Site. Coinlancer may use these technologies to recognize you as a returning user, customize its services, content and advertising, evaluate marketing activities, and collect information about your computer or other access device.

Coinlancer may use various cookies, including but not limited to session cookies, persistent cookies, and “flash cookies.” Coinlancer may codify its cookies to limit access of third parties to the received information.

You can independently control the use of cookies from your browser or browser add-ons; however, blocking or disabling Coinlancer’s cookies may interfere with your use of Coinlancer’s Site.

Coinlancer is not obligated to place cookies on your computer and may do it at its own discretion.

4. Use of Log Files

Coinlancer may use the log files to collect your Internet protocol (IP) addresses, type of browser, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date/time stamp, referring/exit pages, and number of clicks to analyze your activity on the Site, collect geographic and demographic information, and evaluate content of the Coinlancer’s Site. Information collected from log files is not personally identifiable.

Coinlancer is not obligated to use log files and may do it at its own discretion.

5. Storing, Using, and Sharing Your Personal Information

Coinlancer will store your personal information in its database. Coinlancer may contract third parties to store your personal information.

Coinlancer does not sell or rent your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes without your explicit consent. Coinlancer may use your personal information to customize your use of Coinlancer’s Site and services; analyze your activity on Coinlancer’s Site, including through third parties such as Google Analytics and alike; evaluate and improve its marketing efforts and for other reasons relevant to your use of Coinlancer’s Site and services.

Coinlancer may share your personal information with:

- Third parties who provide services to Coinlancer for storing your personal information, fraud prevention, marketing and technology; such third parties are bound by contracts with confidentiality and non-disclosure clauses and may not use your personal information for any reason other than specified in this Privacy Policy.
- Escrow or any other processor of your payment.
- Law enforcement, government officials, or other third parties when Coinlancer is required to provide your personal information by law, subpoena or court order.
- Other third parties with your consent or direction to do so.

6. Change of Privacy Policy

Coinlancer may amend this policy at any time and in its own discretion by posting an updated version on Coinlancer's Site. The updated version becomes effective at the time of posting. It is your responsibility to check updates regularly.
